We have just returned from a week- long trip to Northern Norway on our chartered 100 year old schooner in search of whales and Northern Lights. We were lucky to find many pods of Killer Whales which were seen on three days with a maximum of about 100, many of which right next to the boat. A pod of about 20 Humpbacks joined us for the duration fling their tails just a few meters from us and a couple of Fin Whales added to the spectacle. The Aurora was seen on three nights and great photos were taken. A number of our guests reckon this was the best holiday they have ever had. The sort of comments I enjoy.
